Open air concert

Hupehensis, occuring in October each year, is the sacrificial night ceremony of the Anemone Order. At dusk, the order gathers in the forest behind Wanås castle at a sacrificial birch altar decorated with animal antlers. With fire, song and mystical rites, the order is said to strive to "become one's own flesh" and appease the powers of the forest.

What happens at Wanas when darkness falls and visitors have gone home? Join a largescale, interactive performance by the artist Carola Grahn in collaboration with the male choir Svanholms Singers. A performance that touches topics such as power, religious ceremonies, and the search for a way to live in balance with nature.

The performance is co-produced with KORO -Public Art Norway
